1. Sec State Touch Gala Day

- Day went well again.

- Suggestion for bbg and bush dance at Carinya on the night before the carnival.
- Teams for CIS to be confirmed through Linda.

2. Open Cricket – New format

- Issues with current format
 - Number of school entries is decreasing
 - Schools withdrawing at last minute
 - Distance to travel for some games
 - Number of days out of school as you progress

New Format: Instead of 50/50 one day game CHANGE TO 20/20 cricket

Aim: ALL games including semi's & finals played by end Term 4.

2 Divisions: 15&U and Opens

Max No. Team Entries = 16 per division

Pool Matches to be played in Term 4 with WINNING School to go through to Semi Finals

- Run 4 pools with a maximum of 4 teams/pool
- Schools will be allocated to a pool based on location ie. Sth Coast schools, Sydney schools, Hunter schools, Western Schools etc
- Pool games to be played on **ONE day** at **ONE location**
- Each school would play 3 x 20/20 games in one day
- Each game would take 2 1/2 hrs to play with a 15min change over
- ie. 70min to bowl 20 overs with a 10min change over
- Bowl 10 overs from one end & then change & bowl 10 overs from the other end
- Batsman change ends after each over instead of bowlers
- **Game 1**: 8:30am, **Game 2**: 11:15am, **Game 3**: 2;00pm **Finish** at 4:30pm
- To make participation fair for all players teams must allocate 5 batsmen, 5 bowlers & 1 wicket keeper
- 5 nominated bowlers must bowl at least 2 overs each before anyone else can bowl
- Batsmen retire after 30 runs & can go back in if needed at the end

The OVERALL winning team at the end of the day will go through to play the semi-finals against the winning teams of the other pools

Semi-finals & finals to be played on one day. ie

- Semi Finals played at 9am-11:30am,
- Finals played 12:30pm 3pm

Possible Suggestion: Round Games play 20/20 cricket with semi's & finals 50/50 One day format

Linda will discuss this with the convenor as finals would have to be carried over to Term 1 with a set date.

Pool Games (20/20) played by end of October 2012 Semi Finals (50/50) played by end of November 2012 Finals (50/50) played Thursday 7 March 2013
