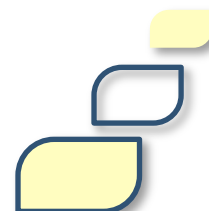

- It is recommended that zones work out the “cost per school” based on the number of students that competed.

CSSA Primary Yr 5/6 State Basketball

- 36 team entries for 2015.
- 20 boys teams & 16 girls teams
- Boys division was closed when 20 team entries was received.
- New format for 2016 to allow for more entries & allow 2 teams in each pool to progress through to quarter finals.
- Option 1: 2 separate days girls / boys
- Option 2: North / South division
- Option 3: Girls venue & Boys venue played on same day

- Country School Overnight Accommodation Request

CSSA Primary State Cricket KO 2016 - New format

- Similar format to the Secondary State Cricket KO Competition. Round 1: Pool Games rather than KO.
- Everyone agreed new format was the way to go in 2016. The secondary format needs to be tweaked for primary students

- Zone Convenor to determine how the bill is split.
- Meet Manager can provide a breakdown of number of student / school participation in REPORTS. Costs can then be split based on participation rates – percentages etc.

- Option 3 preferred option: Girls play at Hawkesbury Indoor Basketball Centre, Boys play at Penrith Regional Sports Centre

- Stagger draw to allow schools to transport teams to both venues ie. Boys start 8:30am, Girls start at 9:30am

- Convenor required for Girls at Hawkesbury
