- → Top 3 to progress from zone to state
- → For Field events at Primary & Secondary State Athletics a qualifying height/distance will be set for 3<sup>rd</sup> place zone competitors only. If they do not achieve the qualifying height/distance they cannot enter that event. The qualifying height/distance does not affect 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> place zone competitors progressing through to state.
- → Will continue in the same format as 2016.
- → Open girls & boys division only for Primary & Secondary GD's
- → Official Oztag rules state that authorised Oztag shorts/tights are to be worn in competition events.
- → Oztag Associations allow belts to be worn only with shorts that DO NOT have pockets.
- → A final decision will be made at the CSSA AGM regarding the use of oztag belts for the CSSA gala day.
- → If Oztag gala days proceed in 2017 the venue will remain at Mamre AS for 2017 with limited number of team entries.
