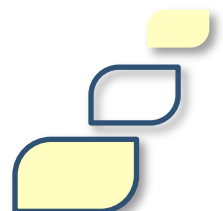

→ Top 3 to progress from zone to state→ Use 10 lanes at SOPAC, extra timekeepers will be required
→ Top 3 to progress from zone to state→ Remove Turbo Jav & 400m from zone/state program→ 1500m WILL remain
→ Top 3 to progress from zone to state
→ For Field events at Primary & Secondary State Athletics a qualifying height/distance will be set for 3rd place zone competitors only. If they do not achieve the qualifying height/distance they cannot enter that event. The qualifying height/distance does not affect 1st or 2nd place zone competitors progressing through to state.
→ Will continue in the same format as 2016.→ Open girls & boys division only for Primary & Secondary GD's
→ Official Oztag rules state that authorised Oztag shorts/tights are to be worn in competition events.→ Oztag Associations allow belts to be worn only with shorts that DO NOT have pockets.→ A final decision will be made at the CSSA AGM regarding the use of oztag belts for the CSSA gala day.→ If Oztag gala days proceed in 2017 the venue will remain at Mamre AS for 2017 with limited number of team entries. |
