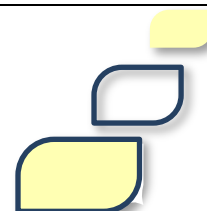

CIS Fees 2019</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ \$5.95 + GST per student</li></ul> <p>Based on August census numbers</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>→ List of CIS Member schools has been emailed out to schools</li><li>→ Tax Invoices have been sent out to schools</li></ul>
<p><b>4. CSSA Calendar 2019</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Primary State Super 8's GD</li><li>○ Primary State Cricket KO</li><li>○ Primary State Softball GD</li><li>○ Secondary State Futsal GD</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>→ Draft Calendar v3 can be downloaded from the CSSA website: <a href="https://www.cssa.net.au/calendar.html">https://www.cssa.net.au/calendar.html</a></li><li>→ Recommendation – Reduce pitch size to 18m length measured stump to stump. For simplicity in measurement, stumps can be brought in at each end to the 2 front crease lines (17.7m)</li><li>→ Recommendation – Reduce pitch size to 18m length (as above) and reduce team size from 11 players on the field to 9 players per team on field at any given time. 7 players minimum are required to play the game &amp; 11 players maximum are allocated to a team</li><li>→ Linda will confirm these recommendations with the convenor &amp; notify schools prior to the events in 2019</li><li>→ Change from <b>Girls to Mixed</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ 9 players on field with no more than a maximum of 4 male players</li><li>○ Batting order must alternate male and female</li><li>○ Teams shall have no more than 2 males in the outfield, 2 males in the infield and 1 male in the pitcher/catcher position</li></ul></li><li>○ Recommendation – Introduce a Yr 3/4 State Mixed T-Ball GD in 2020 held on the same day &amp; same venue as the Primary State Mixed Softball GD. This may have to be on a separate day to the Secondary State Softball GD due to venue restrictions</li><li>→ Introduce a 15&amp;U Girls &amp; Boys State Futsal GD in 2019<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ 15&amp;U Girls &amp; Boys – Thurs 12 September 2019</li><li>○ OPEN Girls &amp; Boys – Friday 13 September 2019</li></ul></li></ul>

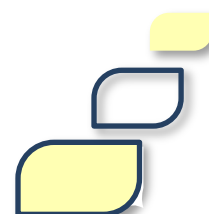

### Introduction

*'For everything God created is good, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with thanksgiving.'*  
(1 Tim 4:4)

- The love of sport ... a worldwide phenomena
- Why teach sport ... in a Christian school?
- Christians and sport ... a hot & cold relationship

### 1. Playing by the Book

#### What the Bible has to say about sport

*The LORD God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it.'*  
(Genesis 2:15)

- What's the point of sport?
- Bible passages speak of running the race, boxing, training, and winning a prize (1 Cor 9:24–27)
- God tells us to delight in creation (Gen 1:31).
- God tells us to develop creation (Gen 2:15) ... the cultural mandate ... this includes sport.
- Sport is a good gift of God – it has intrinsic value ... and instrumental value
- The impact of sin on sport - idolatry ... immorality

### 2. Past and Present

#### The history of Christianity and sport

*'Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ.'*  
(1 Corinthians 11:1)

- Games, gods & gore: Games & religion in the ancient world
- Running the race?: Games & Christianity in the early church.
- Harmless recreation?: Games & Christianity from the C5<sup>th</sup> to C18<sup>th</sup>
- Muscular Christianity?: Sport & Christianity in the C19<sup>th</sup>
  - Modern sport really developed in the C19<sup>th</sup>
  - UK: public schools & churches promoted it
  - Seen as promoting character, community and (with evangelicals) outreach
  - USA: YMCA and Moody championed sport
  - Aust: imported and Australianised the UK view
  - But concerns over impact of professionalism, association with gambling, use of time (incl. Sunday sport), and sport as a "new religion"
- Modern sport: Sport & Christianity in the C20<sup>th</sup> & C21<sup>st</sup> ... a continuation of C19<sup>th</sup> trends
  - A positive: Christian sports ministries
  - A negative: "sportianity"
  - How should Christians think about sport?





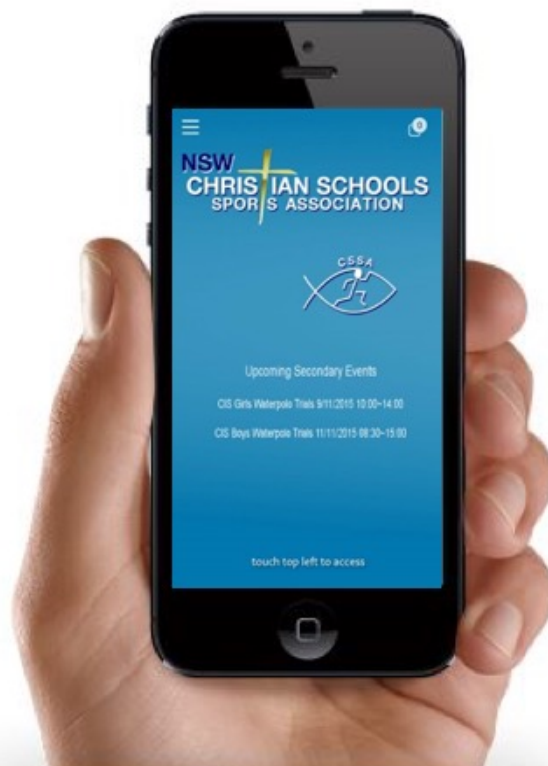
