### ALL Pool games to be played on ONE day at ONE location

- 2 team pools: schools will play 1 x 20/20 game in one day – see semi finals rules
- 3 team pools: schools will play 2 x 15/15 games in one day - Each Games 2 hrs max.
- 4 team pools: schools will play 3 x 15/15 games in one day - Each Games 2 hrs max.

Pools with 3 teams	1v2	3v1	2v3	
Pools with 4 teams	1v2; 3v4	1v4; 2v3	1v3; 2v4	

### Estimate Dates – Check Draw to confirm

- Pool matches completed by end of **Week 5 Term 4**
- Final completed by end of **Week 7 Term 4**

**The pitch size to 18m length, measured stump to stump. For simplicity in measurement, stumps can be brought in at each end to the 2 front crease lines (17.7m)**

**Ball Size:** 142gram balls

### **15 overs per side**

- 3 over max. per Bowler
- Batsman Retire 30 runs. Able to come back in at end of innings, if overs permit.
- 8 overs straight from one end and then 7 overs from the other end.
- Overs - Normal rules to apply. Maximum ball over is 8 balls
- No Ball – **no free hit**

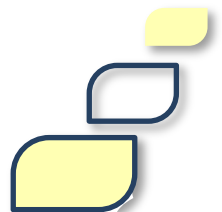
### **20 over games, Semi Final and Final**

- 4 over max. per Bowler
- Batsman Retire 30 runs. Able to come back in at end of innings, if overs permit.
- Overs - Normal rules to apply. Maximum ball over is 8 balls
- No Ball – **no free hit**
- Hosts are responsible for booking sufficient wickets to play pool games.
- Hosts supply (2) dates and contact all schools.
- Agreed dates cannot be changed unless weather intervenes.
- Hosts may negotiate a half-way venue.
- Any issues email or contact Convenor promptly.
- Any **drawn rounds** will be resolved using the Net Run Rate formula and referred to the Convenor.
- **The Final** will be played on a wicket at a half-way venue or an agreed upon venue.
- Schools only enter competition knowing their Term 4 commitments and must be available to play
- Timing/punctuality, a must to ensure games are started and completed on time.

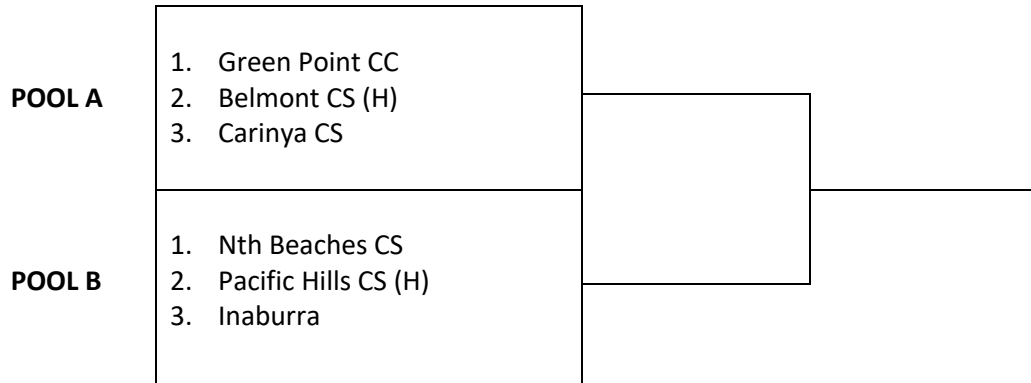
