Schools only enter competition knowing their Term 4 commitments & must be


available to play

CSSA Primary State Cricket KO Competition Organisation and Rules

Team Size 9 players per team on the field.

Teams can be made up of 11 players where some bowl but don't bat - vice versa

Format 20/20 cricket

ALL Pool games to be played on ONE day at ONE location

- 20 overs per team
- Maximum 4 overs per bowler
- Maximum 8 ball over except last over which must have 6 legitimate balls
- No Ball no free hit
 - Optional Wides & No Balls Rule if time is an issue:
 - O Do not re-bowl wides and no balls except for the last over of each innings.
 - This will ensure all overs are only 6 balls (except for the last over of each innings) and ensure the game runs to time.
 - The penalty for bowling a wide or no ball is to be increased to 2 runs instead of 1
 - This rule is to be agreed upon by both coaches prior to the commencement of a game if time is a factor
- Bowl 10 overs from one end, then 10 overs from the other end
- Batters retire at 30 but can come back in if all other wickets have fallen/batters retired too
- 45m boundary depending on field layout, some boundaries might be shorter, so long as it is consistent for both teams.
- Each game should be a maximum of 2 ½ hrs
- Any drawn rounds will be resolved using the Net Run Rate formula

Pitch size

18m length, measured stump to stump. For simplicity in measurement, stumps can be brought in at each end to the 2 front crease lines (17.7m)

Ball Size 142gram balls

Order of Play Game 1: 8:30am **Game 2**: 11:15am **Game 3**: 1:15pm *Finish: 4:30pm*

3 Team Pools 1v2 3v1 2v3

Max. 3 teams in a pool

Dates

- Pool matches completed by end of Week 2 Term 4
- Semi Finals completed by end of Week 4 Term 4
- Final completed by end of Week 6 Term 4

Host School

- The Host School (H) is responsible for booking sufficient wickets to play pool games
- Hosts supply (2) dates and contact all schools
- Agreed dates cannot be changed unless weather intervenes
- Hosts may negotiate a half-way venue
- Any issues email or contact Convenor promptly

The Final: Will be played on a wicket at a half-way venue or an agreed upon venue
