CSSA PRIMARY STATE NETBALL GALA DAY RULES

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- All schools must bring 1 scorer per team which can be a reserve player or a parent
- Scorers must sit with scorers from the opposing team.
- Scorers will score their own team's game.
- Winning team should bring score sheet to the control tower,
- PLEASE LEAVE THE SCORING CLIPBOARD AND PEN IN THE MIDDLE OF THE COURT
- Courts will be numbered according to the map please see the attached map.
- At the end of the rounds, schools can check the results (which will be written up), to find out whether they have made it into a quarter final, semi-finals and grand final.
- Please bring all equipment from school (ball & bibs) for each team.
- Please bring your own first aid kit. There will also be a first aid person in attendance
- All jewellery must be removed before students take the court to play, as well as nails checked.
- Although only the top 2 teams from each pool proceed through to quarter-finals, teams who do not make quarter finals will play in minor finals.
- Junior teams are from Year 3 and 4.
- Senior teams are from Year 5 and 6.
- Open Mixed Teams:
 - Maximum 3 boys on the court at any time
 - Boys must play in a different third of the court ie. GK/C/GA
- Teams of up to a maximum of 10 players.
- No 'netta' rules. Standard netball rules.
- Size 5 ball for both Junior and Senior teams
- Each team is to provide a match ball (size 5) and a set of bibs.
- Schools are required to assist with setting up post protectors on their courts when they arrive.
- As games finish for Quarter final/Minor placings, schools need to bring in post protectors

RULES

- Each game will consist of 2 x 10 minute halves with a 3 min break between halves There will be a 7 minute break between games so teams will need to quickly move to next court.
- If teams arrive late to their games, 1 point will be awarded to the other team for every minute you are late. Umpires will time this from when the hooter goes.
- After 'pool' matches, the top 2 teams from each pool will proceed to quarter-finals. (See draw)
- 3 points will be awarded for a win. 1 point will be awarded for a draw.
- At the end of the "rounds", if two teams are tied, then the team rankings will depend on:
 - o The team that won the corresponding game between those two schools
 - Goals against.
 - If these are still equal then the team that scored the most goals will be ranked higher.
- In quarter finals, semi finals and grand final matches, if there is a draw, then there will be 2 minutes added on. If teams are still tied after this time, the game will continue until one team goes ahead by 2 goals.
- There will be no injury time (until the grand final game). If a player gets injured, normal substitutions can be made. The team must be ready to resume play within 2 minutes.
- The blood rule applies where a player can be substituted for a short period (players must leave the court to be fixed up and can return at the next centre).

State Netball Gala Day - Wet Weather Procedure

Rationale

The Gala Days are designed to bring different forms of Christian schools together in fellowship, around the activities of designated sports. CSSA procedures for these events are written from the Christian conviction that we are to care for those for whom we have responsibility in the way that God cares for us (e.g. Ephesians 6:4). These procedures are also written in light of State requirements for duty of care.

Aims

This procedural document expresses the intent of CSSA to maximise the opportunity for member schools to compete in Christian character, in as safe an environment as possible, and in as timely a way as possible.

Procedures

- 1. A final decision to cancel the gala day will be made at **9am** when all conditions can be assessed and when the weather has had the greatest opportunity to clear.
- 2. As the netball courts are classified as "all weather courts", the state netball convener in consultation with the NSW Umpires may deem it safe to play, even though it may be lightly raining.
- 3. Regular assessments of the playing conditions will need to occur throughout the day if weather conditions change.
- 4. If at **9am** the rain is too heavy the gala day will be cancelled.
- 5. In the case of event cancellation due to wet weather 50% of umpires fee will be paid. Ie. \$70 inc GST which will be billed to schools at the end of Term 3: CSSA Sports Account T3.

This decision was voted on & passed at the CSSA AGM 2015

- 6. Schools may make their own independent decision prior to leaving their base not to come to the day if they decide that there is a high probability that the gala day will be cancelled due to wet weather.
- 7. If they decide not to proceed to the carnival, they must contact the CSSA Executive Officer immediately Linda Heslehurst: 0418 685 898
- 8. Schools will still be charged the full entry fee <u>ONLY if the gala day does go ahead</u> and they decide not to attend.
- 9. If the Netball GD is cancelled we will attempt to rescheduled the event 2 weeks later.
