

CSSA PRIMARY STATE NETBALL GALA DAY RULES

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- All schools must bring 1 scorer per team which can be a reserve player or a parent
- Scorers must sit with scorers from the opposing team.
- Scorers will score their own team's game.
- Winning team should bring score sheet to the control tower
- PLEASE LEAVE THE SCORING CLIPBOARD AND PEN IN THE MIDDLE OF THE COURT
- Courts will be numbered according to the map please see the attached map.
- At the end of the rounds, schools can check the results via QR Code to find out whether they have made it into a quarter final, semi-finals and grand final.
- Please bring all equipment from school (ball & bibs) for each team.
- Please bring your own first aid kit. There will also be a first aid person in attendance
- All jewellery must be removed before students take the court to play, as well as nails checked.
- Although only the top 2 teams from each pool proceed through to quarter-finals, teams who do not make quarter finals will play in play-offs.
- Junior teams are from Year 3 and 4.
- Senior teams are from Year 5 and 6.
- Open Mixed Teams:
 - Maximum 3 boys on the court at any time
 - Boys must play in a different third of the court ie. GK/C/GA
- Teams of up to a maximum of 10 players.
- No 'netta' rules. Standard netball rules.
- Size 5 ball for both Junior and Senior teams
- Each team is to provide a match ball (size 5) and a set of bibs.
- Schools are required to assist with setting up post protectors on their courts when they arrive.
- As games finish for Quarter final/Minor placings, schools need to bring in post protectors

RULES

- Each game will consist of 2 x 10 minute halves with a 3 min break between halves There will be a 7 minute break between games so teams will need to quickly move to next court.
- If teams arrive late to their games, 1 point will be awarded to the other team for every minute you are late. Umpires will time this from when the hooter goes.

POOL RESULTS

If **TWO teams** finish on equal points at the end of the round robin phase, the team to progress through will be determined by:

1. Head to Head game played in the pool game

If there is still no clear placing, then positions will be determined by:

- 2. Points Differential Goals For subtract Goals Against
- 3. Goals scored Against
- 4. Goals scores For
- 5. Team that scored 1^{st} in head to head game *if recorded*
- 6. Coin Toss

If **THREE teams** finish on equal points at the end of the round robin phase, the team to progress through will be determined by:

1. Points Differential – Goals For subtract Goals Against

If there is still no clear placing, then positions will be determined by:

- 2. Head to Head game played in the pool game
- 3. Goals scored Against
- 4. Goals scores For
- 5. Team that scored 1^{st} in head to head game *if recorded*
- 6. Coin Toss

• FINALS – Quarter, Semi and Finals Matches

If there is a draw, then there will be 2 minutes added on. If teams are still tied after this time, the game will continue until one team goes ahead by 2 goals.

• There will be no injury time (until the grand final game). If a player gets injured, normal substitutions can be made. The team must be ready to resume play within 2 minutes.
