PLAYING RULES and DRAW



PLAYING RULES

15&U Games: All matches will be played in **30-minute time slots**. Teams toss at the start of the game for playing direction, **2 x 12 ½ minute halves**. **No half time break**. The ground clock will be started at the beginning of each game so that all games run to time. A long hooter will indicate the end of the game. A **5 minute break between games** has been built into the draw. The **winning team** has the responsibility of sending the score sheet to the convenor in the clubhouse immediately after each game. If no score sheet is returned a nil-all draw will be recorded.

OPEN Games: All matches will be played in **30-minute time slots**. Teams toss at the start of the game for playing direction, **2 x 10 minute halves** with a **5 minute half time break**. The ground clock will be started at the beginning of each game so that all games run to time. A long hooter will indicate the end of the game. A **5 minute break between games** has been built into the draw. The **winning team** has the responsibility of sending the score sheet to the convenor in the clubhouse immediately after each game. If no score sheet is returned a nil-all draw will be recorded.

BARBARIAN TEAMS cannot progress through to the Semi Finals

All games are played under the current rules of Hockey as stipulated by FIH, with the following exceptions:

- Maximum of three (3) boys and a minimum of three (3) girls on the field at all times.
 - No Goal keepers or team goal tending. (Only one player in front of goals with stick on the ground)
 - A goal is awarded for the deliberate use of the foot by a defender in front of the goal. The ball must be on the ground when contacting the foot otherwise the ball has been lifted in a dangerous manner.
 - **In the spirit of the day we ask that no more than ONE player blocks the goal with their stick on the ground.**
 - Barriers down one side (as used in indoor) will allow continuous play.
 - **Due to the reduced size of the field there will be no hitting, flicks, slings or tomahawks permitted.**
 - All penalties awarded inside the Quarter will be taken from one meter outside the area. (there will be no penalty corners). A penalty push is required.
 - A ball put over the back line by a defender will result in a "Long Corner" being awarded to the attacking team.
 - An 18 yard Push (quarter-line) will be awarded to the defending team in all other cases.
 - Goals can only be scored from inside the quarter.
 - Opponents must be a minimum of 4 metres from the ball. (normally 5 when hitting is permitted)
 - Deliberate interference of a penalty push to slow down the play will result in an initial warning followed by a 2 minute sinbin behind the goal if it happens again. (Referee discretion)
 - The ball must move one meter before being played again by the player awarded the free hit or side push.
- All general rules will apply.

GENERAL

- All fields are of synthetic surface, requiring watering from time to time. Entry to the playing fields **MUST be THROUGH THE GATE. Players and coaches must not jump the fence to gain access to the fields.**
- Each school is responsible for its own basic first aid requirements. However, a first aid officer will be in attendance should more serious injuries occur.
- There will be no designated lunch time – each team will need to check the draw for an appropriate time. The canteen will be open throughout the day and serves hot food.
- It helps greatly if all teams are at the Hockey Centre by 8:30 for a short briefing and a prompt start at 9:00am. The draw is very tight and there are forfeiture penalties for teams who arrive late to games.
- **The current forecast for Thurs 18 Feb is showers with a top of 23°. The gala day WILL go ahead based on this forecast. The fields are ALL WEATHER FIELDS & can cope with showers/rain periods. Please ensure you have downloaded the CSSA Mobile App in case the forecast changes.**
- A Disputes and Disciplinary Committee comprising the Convenor and two appointed team coaches will deal with any queries regarding rules and discipline breaches.
- Please be efficient at the changeover between games.

A reminder that all field players must wear both a mouthguard and shin pads whilst playing, under Hockey NSW rules (State Championships: rule 6.6)

CSSA REPRESENTATIVE TEAM SELECTION

- All students contending selection for the CSSA Hockey Teams (both boys and girls) **MUST** obtain a coloured bib from the convenor before commencement of the first game. This must be worn during games for ease of identification.
- Only those players with a coloured bib will be considered eligible for selection by the selectors.
- Students selected to the CSSA Representative teams will need to collect a school permission form to be returned to Amanda Butterworth and try on uniforms for sizings prior to leaving the venue on the day.
- Once selected, students will need to order and pay for the uniforms on line at www.cssa.net.au
- Please note that uniforms must be ordered by **Friday 12 March 2021** to ensure delivery direct to you.

Contact Tracing Requirements

Schools do not need to provide a list of students attending. Details of a contact person from the school who holds the attendance records for the event will suffice. I.e. supervising teaching

Schools must retain a list of all students and staff participating in the event for at least 28 days in accordance with contact tracing requirements.

CSSA is registered with the NSW Government as a COVID Safe business

The Supervising Teacher, Officials & Spectators will be required to register their details by scanning the CSSA QR code via the Service NSW app

Transport

Bus or school transport to and from activities is permitted. Students should sanitise their hands before and after travelling on the bus. Where practical, schools are advised to negotiate with the bus company to implement cleaning protocols prior to student travel.

Face Masks

Students over the age of 12 and staff must comply with the Public Health (COVID-19 Mandatory Face Coverings) Order 2021 when travelling to and from school and during school excursions by public transport, or by chartered or private transport services ie. Car pooling

Equipment Hygiene and Cleaning

<p>Equipment Hygiene and Cleaning Individual schools are responsible for the following:</p> <p>Reduce sharing of equipment where practical and ensure these are cleaned with detergent and disinfectant between use.</p>	<p>Within the constraints of the game, we will implement arrangements to minimise the shared use of equipment where possible.</p> <p>Players and coaching staff will be advised not to share personal equipment including playing equipment, playing kits, bibs, drink bottles and towels. Participants are required to hand sanitise before and after each game.</p> <p>Do not share protective equipment between players if they cannot be easily cleaned & sanitised before being used by another player. This particularly includes equipment such as: helmets, gloves, leg and body guards and groin protectors</p> <p>Where equipment is shared, the equipment will be restricted to a group and rotated to enable disinfectant and cleaning prior to and on the completion of each training/playing session.</p> <p>The sharing of low risk equipment will be limited, with cleaning and disinfecting of equipment before and after use. Ie playing balls</p> <p>Officials and umpires will not hold players apparel or equipment ie. hats. Shirts, helmets, gloves etc.</p>

Finals games will be

No ½ time break

- If teams are drawn at the completion of the normal game time, a five (5) minute period of extra time will be played. If after this scores are still tied a five (5) minute 'golden goal' period will be played.
- If at the end of the golden goal period scores are still tied, one player from each team will 'drop off' the field, with this continuing every two (2) minutes until a maximum of two players remain for each team. The golden goal rule will continue to apply through the drop off period
