## **CSSA Secondary State Cricket Competition RULES**

20/20 Cricket for Pool Games 50/50 One Day Cricket for ¼'s , Semi's & Finals

#### Please ensure you read the new rules & are happy to abide by them BEFORE you enter a team

Divisions: 15&U and Opens

#### Pool Matches to be played in Term 4 2024

- Pool Games (20/20) played by end of October 2024
- ¼'s & Semi Finals (50/50) played by end of November 2024 (if possible)
- Finals (50/50) played Wednesday 12 February 2025 (TBC)

#### **Pool Format**

- Number of pools will depend on number of entries received with a maximum of **4 teams/pool**
- Schools will be allocated to a pool based on location schools must be prepared to travel for their pool games if they are the only school located in their area. It will be up to the discretion of the state convenor to allocate schools to a pool
- ALL Pool games to be played on ONE day at ONE location
- 3 team pools: schools will play 2 x 20/20 games in one day
- $\circ~$  4 team pools: schools will play 3 x 20/20 games in one day
- o Game 1: 8:30am Game 2: 11:15am Game 3: 2:00pm Finish: 4:30pm
- Each game will take 2 1/2 hrs to play with a 15min change over ie. 70min to bowl 20 overs with a 10min change over
- A team will bowl 10 overs from one end & then change & bowl 10 overs from the other end
- o Batsman change ends after each over instead of bowlers
- To make participation fair for all players teams must allocate 5 batsmen, 5 bowlers & 1 wicket keeper
- o 5 nominated bowlers must bowl at least 2 overs each before anyone else can bowl
- $\circ$   $\;$  Batsmen retire after 30 runs & can go back in if needed at the end

The OVERALL winning team at the end of the day will go through to play the ¼ finals or semi-finals against the winning team of another pool
