Students will be selected to represent CSSA at the CIS Hockey Trials CIS Divisions: **15&U** and Open Girls & Boys

Date: Wednesday 28 February 2024

Venue: Macarthur Regional Hockey Complex Millwood Avenue, Narellan

2 Divisions: Open Girls Open Boys

Six-a-side, maximum 10 players per team

No. of Teams: Maximum TWO teams per division per school

Umpires: Qualified umpires will be supplied.

Schools that enter 2 or more TEAMS will be required to supply an UMPIRE to officiate

up to 4 games throughout the day.

Your umpire can be:

• the coach of your team

• a competent hockey parent

ex-hockey student

The umpire **CANNOT** be a student playing in the gala day

Your umpire will not officiate any of your games

Individual Player Entry: Schools that **CAN NOT** field a full team can enter individual players who will be put into a Barbarian Team. Where possible students from the same school will play in the same barbarian team. Schools can enter up to a **MAXIMUM of 5 individual boys and/or 5 individual girls to play in the barbarian teams.**

Barbarian Teams CANNOT progress through to the semis or finals

If a barbarian team consists of players from only 2 schools they will be classified as a COMBINED SCHOOL TEAM & can progress through to the semis & finals

Players in Barbarian Teams will be considered for the CSSA Hockey Teams.

Cost: \$ 154.00 inc GST per team

\$ 20.00 inc GST per individual player (Barbarian team)

Goal Keepers: As small portable goals will be used there WILL BE NO goalkeepers

Goalkeeper trials for the CSSA teams will be held at 8:30am if required – see draw

Requirements:

- Each team is required to supply their own set of shirts per team. Each team MUST have a team coach/manager who is responsible for them throughout the day (parents are OK if appointed by their school). This includes Combined Teams
- Individual players playing on the Barbarian team will have shirts provided on the day.
- Team coaches/managers and players must be aware of the CSSA Code of Conduct and CSSA
 Discipline & Disputes Policy available from the CSSA website
- Each team is responsible for its own basic first aid (inc. ice). A designated First Aid Officer will be in attendance for the day for more serious injuries should they occur.
- Please note that under Hockey NSW rules (State Championship Rules; rule 6.6), all players MUST wear a mouth guard and shin pads whilst playing.

Facilities:

Macarthur Regional Hockey Complex facility has a canteen which sells hot food & drinks. Shower and change room facilities are available.

Wet Weather:

Wet weather will not prevent the event from going ahead as the fields are all-weather. If it is wet students will need dry clothes to change into between matches.

As there is limited shade at the venue schools are advised to bring their own shade shelter for their players in case of inclement weather &/or for sun protection.

General Rules:

- No Goal keepers or team goal tending. (Only one player in front of goals with stick on the ground)
- A goal is awarded for the deliberate use of the foot by a defender in front of the goal. The ball
 must be on the ground when contacting the foot otherwise the ball has been lifted in a dangerous
 manner.
- Barriers down one side (as used in indoor) will allow continuous play.
- Due to the reduced size of the field there will be no hitting, flicks, slings, slaps or tomahawks permitted. JINKING is ALLOWED ankle height
- All penalties awarded inside the Quarter will be taken from one metre outside the area. (there will be no penalty corners). A penalty push is required.
- A ball put over the back line by a defender will result in a Long Corner from ½ way, being awarded to the attacking team.
- An 18 yard Push (quarter-line) will be awarded to the defending team in all other cases.
- Goals can only be scored form inside the quarter.
- Opponents must be a minimum of 4 metres from the ball. (normally 5 when hitting is permitted)
- Deliberate interference of a penalty push to slow down the play will result in an initial warning followed by a 2 minute sinbin behind the goal if it happens again *Referee discretion*

All general rules will apply.

Draw: The draw will be emailed to schools prior to the day.

Format: Games will be 20 minutes in length. However, this may change depending on the final number of team

entries – *see draw*

If a team is 5 minutes late arriving to a game then a 3-point goal will be awarded & then every 3

minutes <u>until the score is 9-0</u>, after which a forfeit will be declared.

Scoring: Win = 3 points Draw = 2 points Loss = 1 point Forfeit = 0 points

If **TWO teams** finish on equal points at the end of the round robin phase, the team to progress through will be determined by:

1. Head to Head game played in the pool game

If there is still no clear placing, then positions will be determined by:

- 2. Points Differential Points/Goals For subtract Points/Goals Against
- 3. Points/Goals scored Against
- 4. Points/Goals scores For
- 5. Team that scored 1st in head to head game if recorded
- 6. Coin Toss

If **THREE teams** finish on equal points at the end of the round robin phase, the team to progress through will be determined by:

1. Points Differential – Points/Goals For subtract Points/Goals Against

If there is still no clear placing, then positions will be determined by:

- 2. Head to Head game played in the pool game
- 3. Points/Goals scored Against
- 4. Points/Goals scores For
- 5. Team that scored 1st in head to head game if recorded
- 6. Coin Toss

FINAL GAMES

- Finals will be played to the same game time as round games.
- A draw at the end of regulation time will see a five (5) minute extra time period played, with the winning team at the end of this time playing through.
- If scores are still tied a second five (5) minute 'golden goal' period will be played.
- If at the completion of this second extra time period scores are still level, then one player from each team will 'drop off', with this continuing every two minutes until a maximum of two players remain for each team.
- The 'golden goal' rule continues to apply for this drop off period.

Disputes: Will be resolved by a committee decided on the morning.

Getting there: A map with directions to the venue will be sent to schools that enter the gala day.


