Wet Weather:

It is difficult to ascertain if the event will be cancelled due to wet weather as the courts dry very quickly. Unless there has been persistent rain for several days prior to the event, it is unlikely to be cancelled! We understand that many students are travelling long distances; however in the event of rain on the morning of the event, no decision will be made prior to 7.30am.

Draw: The draw and any other relevant info will be handed out to players at registration

Format: Singles only. Round robin format. Number of entries will determine how many

players from each pool will go through to quarter-finals etc

Umpires: Players umpire their own games. Teachers/Parents maybe required to assist with

umpiring if players are having difficulty.

Scoring: Scoring has been simplified. Players will play first to 10 points ie. 10-9

Winner for each pool will be decided by the highest total of number of points.

Quarters, Semi's and Finals will be played to determine champion in each

category. In quarters/semis/finals a "set" will be played

Disputes: Will be decided by a committee decided on the morning.

Dress Code: Appropriate "modest" tennis attire or school sports uniform

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded in each category – Champion, Runner up plus Perpetual

Trophy for overall Champion School. To qualify for this team event, a school must have a minimum of 4 players participating. Championship school is decided by total number of points/number of students entered based on Round Games only.
