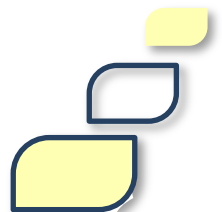
Zones are permitted to enter:

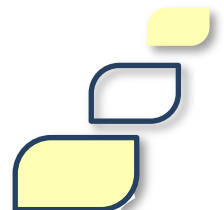
