Times indicated in the program are a guideline only and are in no way binding. Swimmers report immediately to marshaling when calls are made.

1. Competitors must compete in the age division they turn in 2024, other than open events. There is no limit to the number of events a competitor may enter, however they may compete in only one division of any event.
2. For each event competitors will be seeded based on their zone entry time.
3. Competitors are asked to remain within their designated zone area when they are not participating in, or being marshaled for, an event.
4. Listen carefully to all announcements.
5. Times indicated in the program are a guideline only and are in no way binding. Swimmers report immediately to marshaling when calls are made.
6. The starting procedure is as follows:
a) Whistle (competitors move onto the front of the block).
b) Take your marks (competitors move quickly into the starting position).
c) Hooter (which emanates from a microphone located in each block).
7. In the 200m Individual Medley the order of stroke to be swum shall be: Butterfly, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Freestyle
8. Relays will be school based teams, with THREE school-based teams representing the zone in any age division of the relays.
9. Swimmers must stay in their respective lanes until places are allocated and leave the pool when the whistle is blown by the official.
10. Schools are expected to provide adequate supervision for their students throughout the Meet.
11. Schools are responsible to ensure that their students know which event they are in and that they are in correct swimming attire according to the rules of the CSSA Handbook.
12. Protests must be lodged in writing with the carnival referee, ONLY by the official team manager no more than 15 minutes after the completion of the event. Otherwise, the results recorded will stand.
13. Age Championship points at the Primary State Swimming Carnival will be awarded from all individual events.
14. CSSA Primary State Swimming Championships will operate under the NSW Start Rule. There will be no false starts. Swimmers will be automatically disqualified on the first break.

## 16. Costumes

- The object of these rules is to debar immodest costumes.
- For Primary events, the band extending from the front to the rear of male costumes must not be less than approximately 7.5 cms in width.
- Female costumes are to be one piece and devoid of open work except at the back in which the area should be less that 20 cm , should not show any part of the bottom and should not be cut at the side of the swimmer, also be of fully modest design. Costumes must have a round neck and not be shaped to the breast area.
- The texture of all costumes is to be non-transparent.
- NSW approved SWIMSUITS only are permitted at any CSSA swimming carnival
