- **THREE** school based FREESTYLE relays per zone

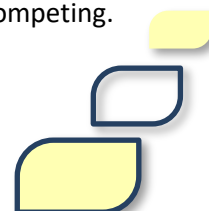
The following events will have a limited number of entries ie. maximum **20 swimmers (2 heats) per event:**

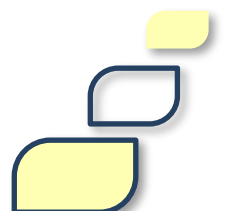
**Teachers responsible for the supervision of student spectators at the State Carnival
