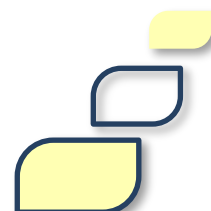

**Supervision:** ALL schools MUST provide either a teacher or responsible adult acting as team manager to supervise their students

**Requirements:** Players must be aware of the CSSA Code of Conduct and CSSA Discipline & Disputes Policy.

**Equipment:** Players/schools will provide their **own table tennis bats and warm-up balls**  
Competition balls will be provided

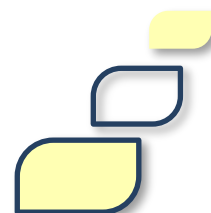
## Competition Rules:

1. Players can only compete in one division on the day
2. The competition will be round robin format progressing into a knock-out stage to ensure maximum games.
3. **Teams that do not progress through to the knock-out stage will play in a Consolation Singles Knock-out draw**
4. Each school group should be accompanied by a responsible adult acting as a team manager
5. The competition between 2 teams will be the best of 5 matches (2 singles, 1 doubles and 2 reverse singles)
6. Players shall umpire the singles matches and the team manager / coach may be needed to umpire the doubles matches
7. Allocation of points as follows: 2 points for a win, 1 point for a loss
8. Medals will be awarded at the completion of the event.
9. Players must compete in their school sport uniform
