

GRANDSTAND

A small covered Grandstand is available for adult spectators ONLY. We ask that schools do not sit in this area as it is reserved for parents and grandparents.

SHADE SHELTERS

Schools are required to bring sturdy shade shelters (which can be secured safely to the ground) for their students to protect them from inclement weather.

Warm clothing & wet weather gear will be required as the wind can be very fierce at the venue.

SUPERVISION

- Please ensure students are supervised at all times
- Students are to remain seated with their school whilst not competing.
- Ball games ARE NOT permitted at the venue.

COMPETITOR DRESS CODE

- Students must compete in approved school/zone sports uniform
- Shoes must be worn at all times
- Bicycle pants/skins may be worn only if they are approved by their school and are the same colour as their sports uniform or black or navy
- o Competitors must start & finish an event in the correct attire
- IPods/headphones are not permitted on the course
- Metal spikes are NOT allowed

CSSA CODE OF CONDUCT

o Please ensure competitors & parents are aware of the CSSA Code of Conduct.

1st AID

- o Schools are responsible for their own basic first aid
- o 1st Aid Officials will be in attendance for more serious injuries
- Asthmatics must carry their medication at all times
- Competitors are to be well hydrated before & after their event
- Competitors should not eat heavy food prior to their event

Individual Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2ND & 3rd place in each event

Certificates will be awarded for 1st to 5th place in each event

Team Medals will be awarded to each member of the winning team in each event

Certificates will be awarded to each member of the team that places 1st, 2nd & 3rd

Team scores are calculated by adding the places of all **4 competitors** in each team. The winning team is the one with the **LEAST** amount of points.

Schools must have 4 competitors to be eligible for the teams event.
